**The Magic of Migration - The Photo Taking Tour in Mai Po 2012**

“The Magic of Migration” - The Photo Taking Tour of Seasonal Birds in Mai Po was successfully held on 18 March 2012. The day was blessed with excellent weather. A total of 24 HKMAPS members enjoyed the event. The morning started off with a talk on the biodiversity of this Ramsar Nature Reserve and the migration of birds in the East Asian - Australasian Flyway with Hong Kong at the heart of it.

The walk to the birdwatching hides was pleasurable. The Gei Wai-s were peaceful. The big cormorants were perching on the trees nearby. The path lead to mangrooves and mudflats abounding with fiddler crabs and mudskippers. The narrow walkway on stilts and drum-floats was a challenge to the carriers of heavy photographic armoury.

Two hides were visited. The first one was by the side of a Gei Wai where egrets caught their feed and glided contentedly in the sun. The other hide was further out on the mudflats with the Shenhen coastline in the back-drop. The spotting of the black-faced spoonbills was announced eagerly with joy. Scores and scores of curlews were in their siesta while the gulls were flying above them.

Patiently the members peered through the narrow viewing slats of the hide and snapped at the right moments. They were totally absorbed in the fun. The excitement and the cherishing of their photographic rewards will last at least till the next visit to this gem of a place.
