## The Jiuzhaigou-Huanglong Tour 20-24 October 2012

Magical Interplays of Colours, Water and Light ~ Dr. WOO Chi Wai; photos by Dr. CHOI Kin and Dr. Amy PANG



Unique Jiuzhaigou-Huanglong is most charming in the fourth week of October when the landscape is painted by Nature with wondrous colours.

Many leaves are in drunken red and flaming orange while others are in an array of mellow yellows and fading greens. The stems are browned with maturity and the vast fields of reeds Monetised in beige. The water in the lakes and ponds is incredibly clear to the bottom; its adorable blue is more precious than turquoise.

The lakes are as smooth as mirrors, reflecting the multitude of autumn colours around. Waterfalls are abundant and copious in flow. Their vigorous plunges give an exciting contrast to the gentile scenery nearby. Photographically, the water becomes endearing strands of silk. The dancing brooks sometimes steal the show; the quieter ones too.

Our trip was greeted by weathers of all sorts. What a treat! The morning chill came with a veil of greyish blue. The first day in Jiuzhaigou was fairly dim. When one began to lose heart, the reassuring sun came into the valleys on the second day bestowing on everything and everyone warmth and radiance. The morning snow was transformed into sparkling water drops, hanging on the branches. The Huanglong trip was preluded by the challenge from a brief snowstorm. The rest of the day was absolutely glorious.

Our group of 26 was comfortably seated in designated vehicles. Among us were notable people of leadership – Dr. CHOI Kin, Dr. CHOW Pak Chin and Mr. YAO Ming, Deputy Director of the Coordination Department of Liaison Office of The Central People's Government and Dr. Amy PANG. We were all there to immerse ourselves in the ethereal beauty of Nature and indeed we did. In sublimation, photography was then not only a means of capturing scenes but also a reciprocal channel for conveying passions for this heavenly place. The rewards were so much more than our picture-frames could hold.
