The idea of showing off our members' photographic works was formed about 1 year ago and was raised during committee meeting.

This was strongly supported by the HKMA Council, our President Dr. TSE Hung Hing, Vice-President and Chairman of the Recreational and Cultural Committee, Dr. CHOW Pak Chin.

An Exhibition Organizing Committee was formed, including Dr. Ivan MAK, Dr. KWAN Wing Ho, Dr. WOO Chi Wai, Dr. Matthew KAM, Dr. James LUK, Dr. John HUNG and Dr. Jenny HUI.

Once "go ahead" was given, we surged ahead with intense planning about 6 months ago.

Booking of venue was fraught with difficulties as many exhibitions happen all the time (Who says HK is a cultural desert?) However, we insisted on using the Foyer of the Hong Kong Cultural Centre as our venue. This is one of the most sought after locations in HK, with high thoroughfare.

The rules of the exhibition needed to be determined. Much debate on the format, such as number of exhibitors, number of photos per exhibitor, etc. occurred. Ultimately the number of photos was limited by the size of venue. We decided to have 80 photos, with one for each person. This was decided so that as many members as possible could participate.

Sourcing photo printer and framer as well as printer for the photo album then took place.

Advertising to members and persuasion efforts to entice more participation was much less difficult than we thought. Many submissions came in from enthusiastic doctors and other members.

**Coming together**

The four weeks prior to D-day saw a hive of intense activity. Supervision of printing quality of photos and the album came under the purview of Dr. Amy PANG.

Our most efficient HKMA staff led by Mrs. Yvonne LEUNG and Ms. Nadia HO, went about organizing the advertising, notifying members as well as contacting media.

Invitation of opening ceremony guests of honour took place 3 months ago, in anticipation of the heavy schedule for such individuals.

Many late night work meetings by Committee ensued, ironing out of all details. In addition to the usual members, several ex-officio members dropped in from time to time and gave much valuable inputs and support. Dr. CHEUNG Hon Ming and Dr. David LAM Tzit Yuen were amongst these.

There was much support received in the form of sponsorships and compliments from individuals and groups. For these we are most humbly grateful.

**Day 1 (19 April) - D-Day**

Day 1 went by relatively uneventfully. The physical setting up of exhibits was close to perfect. Many visitors came, and we received many greetings and bouquets, including those from prestigious photographic societies in HK and overseas. Many individual participants also received greetings. This venue began to resemble a mini Botanical Garden.

**Day 2 (20 April) - Opening Ceremony Day**

The Guests of Honour were spot on punctual and the speeches were well received.

MA Fung Kwok SBS JP, Legislative Council Member (Sports, Performing Arts, Culture and Publication), Dr. Louis NG Chi Wa, Assistant Director (Heritage & Museums), Leisure and Cultural Services Department, Mr. NG Lin Sing MH, (香港中華攝影學會永遠名譽會長), Dr. Leo WONG Kwai Kuen BBS, Honorary Advisor of the HKMAPS, Dr. TSE Hung Hing, Dr. CHOW Pak Chin, Dr. CHOI Kin, President, Vice-President and Immediate Past President respectively of HKMA, and Dr. Amy PANG, Chairman of the HKMAPS.

Being a Saturday there were many invited guests and casual visitors. Amongst them were many who are prominent in the fields of medicine, culture, art and photography.

Our committee members happily mingled with the crowd and proudly showed off our members works.

Dr. KO Wing Man BBS JP, Secretary for Food and Health, took time off his incredibly busy schedule to support us and he studied all 80 photos in detail.

**Day 3 (21 April) – The Closing**

Many more visitors and guests passed through during the day and some stayed on till the very end at 9 p.m.

Our committee members congregated at the venue one last time late in the evening to help with closing the exhibition.

We were at once proud and sad as this fine event came to an end.

We will continue showing these photos in an exhibition tour of many hospitals till the end of the year. This includes main hospitals of the HA clusters throughout HK as well as private hospital. This joint effort combining private and public sector doctors showing their work in a tour which includes public and private sector hospitals is thought to be a historic innovation in all 93 years of HKMA and probably never before in HK.

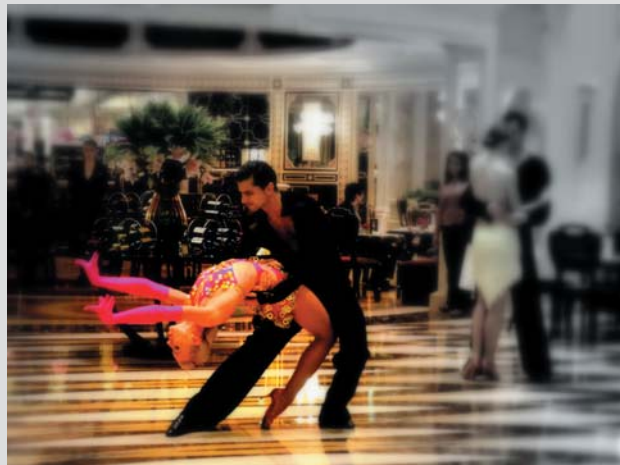
